The certificate recognises not just the hours of reading, reflection and interaction with other participants (either online or in face to face gatherings), but the commitment to the safety and welfare of young people shown by Daniel and the others. Daniel's commitment was evident in his previous role as Child Protection Officer at Br. Beausang Primary in Embulbul, and in his undertaking part-time studies in counselling. *Hongera sana.*
